The Heavy Pets

The Heavy Pets are an American rock and roll band whose contagious vibe blends rhythm and blues, jazz-funk and reggae fusion with homegrown rock and roll. The Heavy Pets are known for powerhouse performances spiked with hot electric licks and multi-climactic instrumental solos, as well as

for their masterful acoustic acumen.

In 2007, the group became an instant Sirius radio sensation with the release of their acclaimed double-disc debut album, *Whale*. The Heavy Pets are regulars at Bonnaroo, moe.down, Langerado, New Orleans Backbeat Jazzfest, and their namesake PetZoo.

The Heavy Pets have amassed a deep catalog of original music that critics call, "full blown musical salvation"; "elegant songwriting with blazing chops, thought-provoking lyrics and a heavy, danceable backbeat"; "funk-reggae rock hybrid that's laid back and sexy"; and "funky, loose-limbed rock and soul." Their undeniable magnetism compels audiences to move and groove along a musical journey full of unexpected harmonic treats punctuated with fantastical lyrics revealing inspired philosophical leanings.

Jai / SOL Temple is a unique Conscious band from the heart of Miami. This music movement was formed to bridge & unite the world of Dance, Yoga and the Power of Sacred Sounds in a way that inspires, up-lifts and transforms all who share in their passion for yoga and conscious evolution. With experiences ranging from Deep Percussion, Meditative Strumming, and Conscious Lyrics merged with Virtuoso Vocals they will provide a memorable performance, every time!

PHisonica is the collective creation of Ankuphara on flute and Eric Dez on guitar and keyboards. The duo feature additional musicians for their live improv jam sessions that weave into their original music. PHisonica's music is best described as World Fusion Downtempo infused with tribal, eastern, old world, gypsy and aboriginal music and powered with passionate guitars, soothing flutes, melodic basslines and Middle Eastern percussion.

sosos is Acoustic Roots Rock Soul with a twist of Acid Jazz...smart, simple music that grabs the average ear as well as the refined. Lush vocal harmonies over dead dry acoustic music down to the 1920's church pump organ makes sosos shine platinum! You can put sosos in any room anywhere to play in front of anyone and they'll make them groove. It's not often you see a band drag out a 1920's church organ to gigs and jam on it. sosos has shared the stage with Blues Traveler, Blind Melon, Tim Reynolds (Guitar Player for Dave Mathews Band), Richie Havens, The Lee Boys, The Subdudes and many others.

Soulflower is taking the world by storm and to a whole other dimension of lyrical expression and perception of what's real. Every word flowed from this Empress is absorbed in consciousness and spirit-forcing the listeners to listen, thinkers to think and musical lovers to hear.
